Eligibility:	<p>All players must have a current up-to-date membership of the BJA, NIJF, WJA, or JudoScotland. All international players must produce proof of membership to their federation.</p> <p>Age Limits:</p> <p>Must be 30 years or older on the day of competition</p>
Weight Categories:	<p>Male: U66kg, U73kg, U81kg, U90kg, O90kg. Female: U63kg, O63kg.</p> <p>JudoScotland would like to include additional age bands and weights in this event. This will be based on the entries received, so early entry is advisable.</p> <p>If an entry of 20 players is not reached by December 15th players will be offered a place in the Senior event if they wish, and the Masters event will be cancelled the entry fee will be refunded if they don't compete.</p>
