GENERAL REGLEMENTATION

COMMITMENT

- Entries will be made by extranet no later than midnight May 19, 2018.
- Registration fee: 15 € (see method on www.judo13.fr)
- Registration will be effective upon receipt of payment.
- For judokas registered but absent (extranet file of May 19th), the amount of registration will be cashed.
- Number of entries limited to 400
- Online registration is mandatory on the event website

SPORTS REGULATIONS

The sports regulations are in conformity with the rules in force of the Judo French Federation (FFJDA).

LICENSE AND MEDICAL CERTIFICATE

For French people

- The contestant must present two (2) FFJDA License stamps
- The contestant presents a medical certificate attesting that there are no contra-indications to the practice of Judo in competition for the season 2017/2018.

For foreigners people

• the signatory certifies that he is dismissed from the national federation of his origin country, insured and in possession of a medical certificate attesting that there are no contra-indications to the practice of judo in competition for The season 2017/2018.

The organizer may refuse a candidate during the passport and weigh-up checks if he does not present the requested documents and will not be reimbursed for his registration.

PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS

- Fighters must have at least two years of licenses and be at least Green Belt holders on the day of the competition.
- Each judoka competes in its age category, determined by its year of birth.
- Combatants with dual nationality may represent only one country.
- Fighters who have participated in an official IFJ international competition (excluding Masters) during the two previous seasons will not be able to participate.
- White judogis should be regulated. The first called fighter will wear a personal red belt.

- All brands of judogis are allowed if they respect the paragraph "holding of the fighters of the official texts of the FFJDA
- Official IFJ or UEJ bibs may remain on the judogis.

ARBITRATION

The competition will be adjudicated in strict accordance with the official regulations of the FFJDA.

WEIGHT CATEGORIES

- Women: -48 kg; -52 kg; -57 kg; -63 kg; -70 kg; -78 kg; +78 kg
- **Men**: -60 kg; -66 kg; -73 kg; -81 kg; -90 kg; -100 kg; +100 kg

CATEGORY PASSAGE ORDER

The order of passage of the age categories is likely to change according to the inscriptions

09h00 M5/M6/M7/M8/M9/M10/M11

11h30 Women & M1

13h30 M2

15h00 M3

16h30 M4

COMPETITION FORMULA

- From 4 to 5 fighters: chickens
- 6 fighters: 2 pools of 3, the first two qualified for the semi-finals
- 7 fighters: 1 pool of 4 and 1 pool of 3, the first two qualified for the semi-finals
- 8 or more fighters: double-draft table
- For 1, 2 or 3 athletes: the organization reserves the right to make coherent groupings of age and / or weight categories, favoring those by the closest age group
- Consideration of the "Ranking List"
- Anti-doping control possible.

AWARDS AND MEDALS

- Awards for the podium in each category:
- The first 4 in the framework of the tables (1st, 2nd and two 3rd), starting from 6 fighters,
- The first 3 in chickens (1st, 2nd and 3rd), between 2 and 5 fighters. The 4th of a group is not considered to be 3rd ex-aequo.

For the French people

The results can be taken into account when establishing a ranking at national level, established by the various French organizers (Tournament Label A).

GRADE/CHAMPIONSHIP RELATION

The grade-championship relation will be applied, in accordance with federal official texts (see "Rules of Leisure Competitions").

- For Judo Committee fighters, the points may be marked on the spot, in agreement with the Regional Organizing Committee of the Degrees (CORG).
- For French combattants from other leagues and committees, the Regional Organizers of Grades (CORG) will move closer to the FFJDA site, to extract the results tables for the validation of points.
- For foreigners, the officials Organizing Committee of the Degrees of the countries concerned will approach the site of the FFJDA, to extract the tables of results and validate the points, if their federation authorized it.

WEIGHINGS AND CHECKS

- Reminder: no registration or weighing on D-Day!
 - Weigh-in and check-in will take place on Friday 25 May 2018 between 18:00 and 21:00 at the venue: Gymnasium PIOT 344 Avenue Rhin Danube, 13127 Vitrolles.
 - A second weighing site may be proposed depending on the number of participants and the place of accommodation.
 - It will be imperative to respect the slots of the weighing.
 - No weight tolerance
 - An official weigh-in of judokas drawn at random will take place the morning before the first competition matches. The weight of the athlete cannot be more than 5% (without judogi) than the limit of the official maximum weight of the category. Example: -73 kg shall not exceed 76,650 kg

ACCREDITATIONS, Accompanying person

- Each competitor will be given an accreditation at the time of the weigh-in, the day before the competition.
 - Accreditation will be required during the competition, to enter the warm-up zone or, at the call of the competitor's name, to the competition zone.
 - Only one coach will be allowed per athlete in the competition area, he will show up with the athlete and leave the competition area with the athlete at the end of the bout.
 - A single coach badge will be sent to the club representative for 5 athletes, against the payment of a 5 € refundable deposit at the end of the competition.
 - No Coach in kimono. Correct outfit required.
