Athletes must be minimum age of 30 years by year of birth, born in 1989 or before.

Hold a National Federation's membership currently affiliated to the IJF.

Hold minimum 1st Kyu.

Athletes must not have represented a National Team in a competition at international senior level at any time in the twelve months period before the start date of this particular Japan Veteran International Judo Championships i.e. between $20^{\rm th}$ May 2018 and $17^{\rm th}$ May 2019.

8. Control of entries and registration

Entries should be submitted by the National Federation. However, in the case of any difficulty in arrangements, entries will be accepted through clubs or even individuals. Passport or photocopy of passport must be available during the registration.

9. Competition Rules

Competition will be carried out according to the IJF Referee Rules. There is no Golden Score for all divisions. Winner will also be decided by Shido difference.

<Individual>

The winner will be decided by Waza-ari or above.

If there is no difference between two athletes at the end of the competition, the one with less Shido will be the winner. If there was no difference in Shido, the winner will be decided by flag decision.

Weight category

Female: -48 kg; -52 kg; -57 kg; -63 kg; -70 kg; -78 kg; +78 kg Male: -60 kg; -66 kg; -73 kg; -81 kg; -90 kg; -100 kg; +100 kg

*The organizer may combine two or more categories depending on the number of athletes.

<TEAM>

The winner will be decided by Waza-ari or above, or 2 Shido difference.

If there is no difference between two athletes at the end of the contest, the result will be 'Hikiwake' (draw). (No Golden Score system)

The winner team will be decided by the number of victories.

If there is no difference between two teams, the winner will be decided by the number of Ippon.

If there is still no difference, the winner will be decided by the number of Waza-ari.

If there is still no difference, an extra match between 1 selected representatives from each team will be conducted to decide the winner. The duration of this match is 2 minutes. As there is no Golden Score system, Waza-ari or Shido will not conclude the competition. And if there is no difference at the end, the winner will be decided by flag decision.

Female team

Team consists of 3 athletes.

There is no age and weight limit.

Duration is 2.5 min and order of the competition will be from youngest to oldest.

Male team

Team consists of 5 athletes. The order of the competition will be from youngest to oldest, from each following age category.

There is no weight limit.

2 nd	40-49	2.5 min
3^{rd}	50-59	2.5 min
$4^{ m th}$	60-69	2.5 min
$5^{ m th}$	70 over	2 min

If there is no athlete who satisfies one of the age categories of your team, an athlete from one older age category can fill the spot. However, no one can replace the age 70 over category.

<Kata>

Competition will be carried out of following kata. Nage no Kata/ Katame no Kata/ Kime no Kata / Ju no Kata Kodokan Goshinjutsu / Itsutsu no Kata/ Koshiki no Kata

Athletes can apply a maximum of 2 different Kata.







The organizer will provide Kime no Kata and Kodokan Goshinjutsu's Weapons.

Competition will be carried out according to IJF Kata Rules.

10. Weigh-in

Weigh in for individual competition will be held as follow and all athletes for the individual must attend the weigh in with accreditation card.

*18th May (Sat) 15:00-17:00 at Ehimeken Budokan

11. Judogi

Athlete must have back number with name and country.

Judogi shall only be white and the size must conform to the current IJF regulations. Judogi control with Sokuteiki will be conducted.

12. Insurance

Athletes themselves, athletes and team officials, must assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities (third party cover). They must have insurance either held personally in the form of specific insurance cover or travel cover (which does not exclude participating in judo competition) or as part of their National Federation insurance arrangements. Neither Organizing office nor All Japan Judo Federation will not be responsible of any claims of illness, Injury and death, of any participants/officials.

13. Visa

For nations which require a Visa to enter Japan, please fill in the Visa application form and send us by e-mail.

Visa Application form must be applied through National Federation.

Deadline: 13th April

14. Anti-doping control

The Organizer has strong anti-doping policy, but there will be no anti-doping control at this Championships.

15. Particular rules for female athletes

The Female athletes must wear a white plain t-shirt. Long hair has to be bounded with an elastic band. Wearing Make-up or accessories is prohibited. The nails have to be cut short.

16. Important information

a) All medalists must attend the medal ceremony with full white Judogi.

b) All athletes should be available to compete at least 45 minutes prior to the estimated start time.
