Please be advised that the closing date for entries will be Tuesday 7th March 2017 Midnight. The online entry system will automatically shut down when close date has passed. Requests for late entries will be considered up to 8th March 2017 and if accepted will incur the cost of an additional €20.00.</p>

A maximum of 3 coach accreditations will be issued to each club. Coach Accreditation will be issued on the day at a cost of €5.00. Coach Accreditation will be ready for collection at the official Weigh-in following online entry. No Coach Passes will be issued on the day. Coach Accreditation is required for access to the mat area. Coach Accreditation will be issued by name and is non-transferable. Parents or Volunteers will not be issued Coach Accreditation for this event.</p>

Accommodation	There is no official hotel for this event.
Transfer	All individuals must arrange their own transport.
Media	Any person who wishes to photograph the event should apply for accreditation at the official Weigh-in. This is in line with Best Practice regarding Safeguarding for Children in Sport. Media Accreditation will only be issued to those who complete the accreditation form; ID may be required so please bring driver's licence/passport. Please adhere to this policy.
Anti- Doping	Shall be conducted in conjunction with Sport Ireland Anti-Doping Rules which are compliant with the World Anti-Doping Code and tests shall be conducted in line with best practices.
Draw	Will be done prior to the event. Where a competitor (save for a minor) fails to make the weight category a fee of €5.00 will be required to change weight category. This can only be collected by way of cash at the weigh in desk.

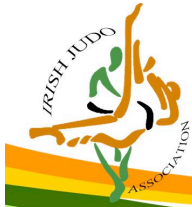

Competition Mode	All competitors will have a minimum of two fights and either the pool system or double reperchage shall be used. For all other competitors, competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF/ EJU KO system. Evidence of membership with the Irish Judo Association or competitors affiliated National Governing Body must be produced on check-in.
Judogi & Judogi Control	The competition will be held in white and blue judogi and in line with the rules as set down by the IJF and EJU. Where a competitor elects to wear a blue judogi, he/ she must also have a white judogi available to conform to the rules. Women must wear a white non-transparent t-shirt. Bras must not have any hard pieces. Long hair must be tied up with the appropriate elastic band. Make up and jewellery are prohibited. Nails should be cut short. The judogi control will be performed by the referees.
Insurance	Each club is responsible for insuring its competitors against injury and third party risk during the relevant period. The Irish Judo Association will not accept any liability for any loss or damage howsoever arising.

Saturday 11th March 2017	Official Weigh-in for Minors, Pre-Cadets, Cadets Official Weigh-in for Juniors, Seniors & Veterans Venue: Foyle Arena, 2 Limavady Road, Derry BT47 6JY There will be no weight tolerance for Veterans, Seniors and Juniors. A weight tolerance of 0.5kg will be given to Minor, Pre-Cadet & Cadet Men and 0.6kg for Minor, Pre-Cadet & Cadet Women. All judoka must present appropriately attired for the weigh-in. Competition for Minors & Pre-Cadets will start no earlier than 10.30 Competition for Cadets & Juniors will start no earlier than 12.30 Competition for Seniors & Veterans will start no earlier than 13.30 Presentation of medals will take place after each section is completed.
