	 This is a Level 4 event, BJA rules will apply throughout the event and will be in accordance with the Tournament Handbook. The decision of the Tournament Director will be final. 				
	The method of competition will be Pools or Compound Knockout.				
	The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate adjacent weight/age categories depending on the number of entries in the respective weight categories.				
	• This event will adhere to the mat side coaching rule in all categories. In the following way: Coaches in the official mat side position can only advise the athlete during the mate-hajime period and NOT while the contest is in progress. Should any mat side coach not adhere to this guideline they will firstly be reminded of this rule by the referee and on receiving the second reminder in the same contest will need to remove themselves to the general public area for the rest of the event on that day. Other personnel who insist on shouting coaching points will also need to remove themselves to the general public seating area.				
	The wearing of white & blue judogi is not compulsory for this event, but if you have a blue suit you must also have a white suit.				
	Medals will be presented after the finals
