

<u>Weigh-in</u> possibilities (at the tournament venue): The night before (Saturday, April 11) from 6:00PM to 7:00PM, or, The day of the tournament (Sunday, April 12) from 7:30AM to 8:00AM

Warm-up and Draw: 8:00AM to 9:30AM

Start of competition: 9:45AM

## Regulation

Open to male and female Judokas born in 1990 and before.

Depending on the numbers of participants, the competition will be in round-robin pool or in tournament format; or both (for example, a sixteen player division will fight in four pools, each pool is round-robin so each player will have at least three matches before the top two from each division will go into the tournament style quarter-final.

It is possible to combine the official weight categories and age groups (M - F). Depending on the number of participants. The goal is that everyone can maximize their number of fights, while ensuring they will fight against someone similar weight and age.

Minimum Grade: yellow belt.

Refereeing Rules: FFJDA.

Combat time: 3 minutes.

License: Holder of your club or national judo license for practice and competition

Medical: A medical provider will be present throughout the competition

# **COMPETITION Venue**, transportation and lodging information

The venue *Halle Didier Parapillion* regularly hosts departmental, regional and national competitions for judo. It has a large capacity to host fighters and public. It is 10 minutes by car/taxi from the Chambéry SNCF railway station and 2 min from the Urban expressway giving access to the motorway of Lyon or Grenoble.
