<b>Age Bands:</b>	Masters (see categories for break down)
<b>Competition Format:</b>	Contest times will be 3 minutes for categories M1/F1 to M6/F6 and 2.5 minutes for M7/F7 and above with a one minute golden score. Rules: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This is a Level 3 event, BJA rules will apply throughout the event and will be in accordance with the Tournament Handbook. <b>The decision of the Tournament Director will be final.</b></li> <li>• The method of competition will be Pools or Compound Knockout.</li> </ul> The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate adjacent weight/age categories depending on the number of entries in the respective weight categories. The wearing of white & blue judogi is not compulsory for this event, but if you have a blue suit you must also have a white suit. Medals will be presented after the finals This Tournament qualifies for points scoring for promotion purposes.

<b>Registration and Weigh In:</b>	<p><b>Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2022</b></p> <p>MK1 and MK2 – 0845 to 0915</p> <p>Categories M1 to M3: 1000 to 1045</p> <p>Categories M4 to M9: 1200 to 1230</p> <p>All Women’s categories: 1330 to 1400</p> <p>All competitors <b>MUST</b> bring their <b>VALID</b> judo licence (BJA or affiliate) to registration and also their record book showing they meet the minimum grade.</p> <p>Players must satisfy the minimum weight limit for their category, ie for -81kg players must weigh over 78.5kg.</p>
<b>Judogi:</b>	<p><b>The wearing of white judogi is compulsory for this event.</b></p> <p>Reversible judogi is not acceptable.</p> <p>If you bring a blue judogi, you <b>MUST</b> also bring a white one.</p> <p>Backpatches may be worn but must be official EJU/IJF backnumber with Name and Country.
