Participation	Must be eligible to represent GB. If you are uncertain of your eligibility, please contact the organiser.
	Competitors must hold current BJA or affiliate membership. All competitors MUST bring their VALID judo membership card to registration along with their record book which shows they meet the minimum grade.
Age Bands:	Masters
Competition Format: Weight Categories:	 Contest times will be 3 minutes for M1-M6 and F1-F6. M7/F7 and above, contest times are 2.5 minutes. Rules: This is a Level 3 event, BJA rules will apply throughout the event and will be in accordance with the Tournament Handbook. The decision of the Tournament Director will be final. The method of competition will be Pools or Compound Knockout. The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate adjacent weight/age categories depending on the number of entries in the respective weight categories. This event will adhere to the mat side coaching rule in all categories. In the following way: Coaches in the official mat side position can only advise the athlete during the mate-hajime period and NOT while the contest is in progress. Should any mat side coach not adhere to this guideline they will firstly be reminded of this rule by the referee and on receiving the second reminder in the same contest will need to remove themselves to the general public area for the rest of the event on that day. Other personnel who insist on shouting coaching points will also need to remove themselves to the general public seating area. The wearing of white & blue judogi is not compulsory for this event, but if you have a blue suit you MUST also have a white Judo Gi. This Tournament qualifies for points scoring for promotion purposes.

	All Female Groups: 12:00pm to 12:30pm Group: MK1 and MK2: 13:00pm to 13:45pm All competitors MUST bring their VALID judo license (BJA or affiliate) to registration and also their record book showing they meet the minimum grade.
	Players must satisfy the minimum weight limit for their category, ie for -73kg players must weigh over 66.5kg.
	An Open Weigh In will be taking place therefore all male judoka must weigh in with Judo Gi trousers and will have a 0.8kg allowance if they are wearing a plain white t-shirt .
	A 0.7kg allowance will be given to male judoka whom wish to weigh in without a plain white T-Shirt.
	All female judoka must weigh in wearing a plain white T-Shirt and Judo Gi trousers. A 0.8kg allowance will be given to all female judoka.
Judogi:	The wearing of white judogi is compulsory for this event. Reversable judogi is not acceptable.
	If you bring a blue judogi, you MUST also bring a white one.
	Backpatches may be worn but must be official EJU/IJF backnumber with Name and Country. Back patches can be ordered from either: <u>www.mybacknumber.com</u> or www.ijfbacknumber.com
Closing Date:	All entries must be received by 29 th SEPTEMBER 2023
Entry Fee	£30 Single Entry Fee – Open Grade / Kyu Grade Event Double Entry Fee: £45 MK and FK players may also enter the Open grade event if they wish
