Eligibility:

This is a <u>development</u> event limited to judoka age 8 years old and under 16 years old, Novice to 9th Mon and Senior Judoka graded Novice to 2nd Kyu.

All red belt players must have been graded within the last 6 months and yellow and orange belts must have been graded within the last 9 months. Please ensure that record books have been updated accordingly.

This is a development event for young judoka therefore if you have won a medal at any of the following events British National Minors Championships 2023, British National Masters Championships in 2023 you will be ineligible to participate in this event.

Competitors MUST produce a valid BJA or affiliated association membership card and record book at weigh in, failure to produce a valid membership card and proof of grade will mean no participation – no refund of entry fees.

NO VALID LICENCE - NO CONTEST - NO EXCEPTIONS

Format:

Players will be grouped into pools of 4/5/6 players of their weight, where possible, based on the age/grade groups below. However, some groups may need to be merged, and in these instances, it will discuss with the coaches of the affected players.

Players In Group A-D will fight in their weight groups and will receive medals for these groups, the tournament director reserves the right to combine or alter weight categories should entries dictate. In the event of any dispute the decision of the tournament director will be final

Please ensure there is a contact email address for any queries to be resolved prior to the event.

White Judogi only. Competitors are not allowed to change anywhere other than in changing rooms.

Medals will be presented after each group, where possible, and all competitors will receive an award for competing.

If a player is graded and this grading leads to a change in the players colour of belt, you must inform the competition organiser via email before the day as this can change group sizes and could mean a change of weigh in time for the player.

Only accredited coaches are allowed mat side when their players are competing and may be asked to produce their pass by any official.

All competitors under age 18 MUST present themselves to the weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers and a **Plain White T-shirt**. Please see updated allowance in table below.
