TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES & RULES

- IJF rules apply. Judo Canada and Judo Alberta Sanction Policy as of the tournament date will be enforced. The Tournament Director reserves the right to make any changes in the best interest of the event/contestants.
- White judogi is mandatory for U10 & U12. Blue judogi is optional.
- Novice divisions may be combined with Intermediate (if applicable) or Advanced divisions if low registration.
- White & blue judogis are MANDATORY for all Advanced U16 & older
- U14, U18, U21, Veteran & Ne-waza athletes who compete in U16 or Senior on Sunday, will NOT have to weigh in twice for the same weight division.
- If withdrawing from a division, report to joseki (head table).
- Novice, Intermediate and International athletes cannot register as an "early bloomer".

Athletes who coach MUST register

Register by February 17, 2024 to receive a t-shirt; MUST register by February 29, 2024 (no exceptions). ALL Canadian Provincial/Territorial Coaches MUST be minimum Competition Development trained. Assistant Coaches must be Dojo Instructor trained. Foreign coaches must provide their coaching certification equivalency.

IF YOU ARE NOT NCCP CERTIFIED, YOUR COACH REGISTRATION WILL BE WITHDRAWN. CHECK YOUR NCCP COACH LOCKER FOR ACCURACY.

REFEREE SYMPOSIUM/COACHES MEETING

A figure often overlooked in competitive fighting is the third person on the mat. Referees are responsible for more than casual observers may give them credit for. They are responsible for ensuring fair competition between two fighters abiding by a set of rules. A referee's level of involvement in a match will often affect the flow of competition, which ultimately affects what we view as spectators. Referees are needed to make a competition possible. No matter how you encounter Judo, the Referee Symposium is to provide useful tips and information for personal development and training on the rules. We highly recommend that all referees and coaches consider attending. Bring your gi.
