8. TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

Participants of the 2nd JUDO MASTERS CUP GLIWICE VETERANS and AMATEURS competition may be:

In the Veteran category:

Players born in 1994 or earlier, who have not been classified in the PZJ rankings in the last five years and have not participated in competitions under the patronage of the PZJ (except Masters and Kata competitions) and have training levels from 2 kyu and above. Age division of the category: 5 years.

Age division:

M1/F1: 30-34 years (1994-1990) M2/F2: 35-39 years (1989-1985) M3/F3: 40-44 years (1984-1980) M4/F4: 45-49 years (1979-1975) M5/F5: 50-54 years (1974-...1924)

Fight time:

M1/F1: 30-34 years old – 3.5 minutes M2/F2: 35-39 years old – 3.5 minutes M3/F3: 40-44 years – 3 minutes M4/F4: 45-49 years – 3 minutes

In the Amateur category:

Players born in 2004 or earlier, who have not been classified in the PZJ rankings in the last five years and have not participated in competitions under the patronage of the PZJ (except Masters, Amateur and Kata competitions) and have training levels from 6 kyu to 3 kyu inclusive. Age division of the category: 5 years

Note: In the Amateur group, the AMO/AFO category was created in the age group of 20 - 29 years.

Age division:

AM0/AF0: 20-29 years (2004-1995) AM1/AF1: 30-34 years (1994-1990) AM2/AF2: 35-39 years (1989-1985) AM3/AF3: 40-44 years (1984-1980) AM4/AF4: 45-49 years (1979-1975) AM5/AF5: 50-54 years (1974-...1924)

Fight time:

AM1/AF1: 30-34 years old – 3.5 minutes AM2/AF2: 35-39 years old – 3.5 minutes AM3/AF3: 40-44 years old – 3 minutes AM4/AF4: 45-49 years old – 3 minutes AM5/AF5: 50-54 years old – 3 minutes

Men's weight categories (tolerance +1kg):

-66 / -73 / -81 / -90 / -100 / +100 / kg

Women's weight categories (tolerance +1kg):

-52 / -57 / -63 / -70 / +70 kg

A competitor with one opponent fights until he wins twice.

The following rules apply to the team competition:

4 weight categories regardless of age and veteran/amateur division

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-73kg -81kg -90kg +90kg
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The winner of the match is determined by the number of fights won (not points for ippon or waza- ari). A fight finished in regular time without scoring actions ends in a draw. No overtime. In the event of a final draw of 2:2 (1:1), the winner will be decided by an additional fight in one of the drawn weight categories, conducted to determine the winner (golden score – no time limit).

The given team composition may consist of a maximum of 8 players, of which 2 may be players from other clubs. We require that a given team has a representative in each weight category in each match.

Team composition is provided by the coach or team captain when registering the team for the team tournament (on the day of the competition at the competition office).

In the given lineup for a given match, there can only be one person selected from another club. Team lineups for a given match are announced by the coach or team captain immediately before the match.

The format of the team tournament will depend on the number of registered teams.

Competitors should have a document confirming their identity.

Competitors participate in the competition at their own risk, which they confirm with their own signature during the weight check.

The organizer reserves the right to combine weight, age or training categories if there are no competitors in a given category.

The tournament will be held on 3 mats according to the currently applicable PZJudo regulations.

As a rule, competitors wear white or blue judogi that meet the regulatory requirements regarding dimensions. Judogi do not have to have a certificate or the weight required by the IJF. If the player does not have the above-mentioned judogi goes into battle wearing white clothes and additionally puts on a red belt.

If the duel is not resolved within the regular time, the fight will continue in the "Golden" formula Score "with a time limit of 1 minute to score a point (winner) or penalty (loser). In case of a tie, the Referee will select the winner.

10. PRIZES

- for the winners of places from I to III medals, diplomas and gifts from FA
- Everyone else diplomas

The competitors will be decorated after the fights in a given weight category have ended.

- Organizational costs are covered by the organizers
- Participation costs are covered by interested persons or clubs

11. INSURANCE

The organizer is not responsible for accidents, injuries or injuries occurring during the competition. Competitors insure themselves and at their own expense. Accident insurance should cover injuries and accidents incurred while practicing high-risk sports and extreme disputes (so-called Sports Insurance).
