- This tournament is a selection tournament for U16, U18, U21 and Senior athletes wishing to participate in the 2024 Canadian Open National Championships.
- For the U10 & U12 divisions this is a friendly competition with no scores recorded or overall winners selected. For the U8 division this will be a demonstration event only, not a competition.

ELIGIBILITY

All participants must be a current member of a provincial judo association and Judo Canada. Photo ID will be required at weigh-in for all U18 and older aged athletes.

EARLY BLOOMER

Early Bloomer is a clause that allows exceptional athletes to compete in a higher aged category. For more information about the Early Bloomer clause please contact your club coach. Athletes born in 2013 entering U14, athletes born in 2010 & 2011 entering U16, or athletes born in 2010 entering U18 who qualify as an "Early Bloomer" must submit the Early Bloomer waiver, signed by a parent and coach. Please upload your Early Bloomer waiver in Trackie at the time of registration. The waiver is posted in the Trackie registration in the Additional Information "Documents" section.

All participants must pre-register by the deadlines for this tournament. This includes coaches, referees, kata evaluators, athletes, and chaperones.

NO REFUNDS will be issued after March 19th unless the competition is cancelled by Judo BC due to unforeseen circumstances such as government pandemic closures.

RULES & COMPETITION FORMAT

Format of all age divisions as per current <u>Judo Canada Sanctioning Policy & Tournament Standards</u>. Please note the following:

U8:

Demonstrations of throw to hold downs and escapes. Each participant will have several opportunities to demonstrate with different partners.

The following actions are not allowed:

- Kansetsu-waza and Shime-waza
- Head locking with a grip over or around the neck both in Tachi-waza (no Kubi-nage) and Newaza
- All drop down techniques, which start on one or both knees.
- Tani-otoshi.
- Makikomi-waza.
- Sutemi-waza.

^{*} Weight division changes can be made free of charge up to 2 days prior to the start of the competition - midnight PDT Thursday April 4th.

U10 & U12:

- Weigh-in: Honor System (Provided by the parents, checked by club coach), the list will be sent to coaches 1 week prior the event.
- There will be a scale for spot checks should concerns arise. We ask that Club Instructors verify the athlete's weights. Discrepancies between reported weights and actual weights may result in disqualification without refund.
- White judogi required.

All issues/cases(s) that are unexpected or deemed exceptional circumstances will be solved by decisions taken by the Judo BC designated Chief Official in cooperation with the Tournament Director.

AWARDS

In the U8, U10 & U12 divisions every competitor will receive a medal and no provincial champion will be declared.

For all other divisions, medals will be awarded for first, second and third place according to the Judo Canada Tournament Standards. All medal winners must win at least one match.

Medalists are required to wear their WHITE judogis on the podium.

Medal ceremonies will take place at the completion of each division.
