Costs and pre-registration: Organizing cost paid by the organizer. Other costs (eg. accommodation, meal, entry fee, etc.) are covered by the participants. The entry fee must be paid in Euro, any other currency won't be accepted. At the finalization of the entry (at the venue) all the participants should have a valid passport and the competitors are obliged to show their passport by the final entry.
