The Kodokan membership card will be presented during the seminar.
Data protection and privacy:	By registering for this event, participants consent to the electronic storage of their personal data and its publication in notices, online, and in other publications of JVB and DJB, as well as their respective subdivisions. The same applies to photographic and video documentation. By participating in the event, participants agree that their personal data (last name, first name, date of birth, address, e-mail address) may be processed and stored by JVB and transferred to the DOSB License Management System (LIMS) for the purpose of issuing licenses. The DOSB does not have access to the personal data of license holders at any time. Consent to the transfer of data may be revoked at any time with effect for the future. In this case, however, a DOSB license cannot be issued!
